4. [REDACTED] Junta relations with DINA have changed considerably since the early days of the intelligence organizations establishment. [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] since the promulgation of Decree Law No. 521, officially establishing DINA as the national intelligence arm of the government (ref (b) refers), Colonel CONTRERAS has reported exclusively to, and received orders only from President PINOCHET, [REDACTED]

5. [REDACTED] When DINA was first setting-up operations, their headquarters were located in three houses on Belgrado Street, in Santiago (near the intersection of Vicuña McKenna and Rancagua). Presently, however, they [REDACTED] are building a 24 story building at the end of Belgrado Street to serve as their national headquarters. The expected completion date of this new headquarters is as yet unknown.
