- 1. I strongly recommend that we give these cables to the FBI intact rather than editing them.
- a. The FBI knows that we communicate by cable. They will probably ask for the originals. If they were to suppensathem, I do not know how we could resists.
- b. The General Walters connection may or may not be important. Besides Stroessner, Colonel Manuel Contreras considers himself a bosum buddy of the General. I think that the FBI should know. The General is an old hand. He can take care of himself.
- c. If the fact that we intentionally witheld information on the Letelier investigation became public, we would be subject to a storm of criticism. I recognize that we run the risk of leaks. In my judgement we run greater risks if we appear to withold information.
